## HCI helps flood victims

**PESHAWAR:** The Human Concern International (HCI), a non-governmental organisation (NGO), has distributed bags of flour, ghee as well as free of cost medicines among the flood affected of Peshawar.

## Relief goods distributed among flood-hit families

**PESHAWAR**—The Human Concern International (HCI) has distributed medical relief goods among 151 flood affected families at Pir Bala, Peshawar on Sunday, said a statement.

The HCI has been carrying out relief work in flood affected areas since August 4, 2008 after devastating earthquake hit Peshawar suburbs and the adjoining Khyber Agency affecting hundreds of families.

The HCI started immediate relief activities through dozens medical teams that treated more than 2500 patients, the statement added. The HCI provides free medical facilities and medicines to the victims.

The statement added that HCI also collected damage information in various affected areas and on the report of assessment team one million rupees were allocated for provision of food package and help the victim with food items.

The HCI also planned to help the needy and poor people in Pakistan, Afghanistan and Kashmir with its Ramazan feeding programme in the holy month of Ramazan, and it also appealed to other NGOs to join hands for the noble cause, the statement concluded.
